General Collection of Children Policy 2024/25

Caythorpe & Fulbeck Junior Football Club requires all Parents/Carers ('Parents') to bring their child/children to training sessions and matches at a number of venues, including:

- Caythorpe Playing Fields
- Fulbeck Playing Fields
- Sir William Robertson Academy, 3G Pitch, Welbourn
- Carres Grammar School, 3G Pitch, Sleaford

Details of training times and venue locations for each age group can be found on the club website – www.cfjfc.net – and confirmed by their manager.

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that children remain in a safe environment whilst attending any of the above venues.

Parents/Carers ('Parents') are required to bring their child/children in person to the designated football pitch, they must accompany their child/children to the pitch side and must ensure that their coach is present.

Parents are required to remain at the venue for the duration of training/match. During the training/match period one CFJFC coach will remain with the children on pitch yet if a child needs to leave the pitch temporarily they must be accompanied by their parent/carer. For instance, if your child needs to go to the toilet during the session.

If Parents need to leave during a training session or match, then they should appoint a 'responsible individual' (i.e. another parent) to cover any situation until they return to the venue. The parent must advise the coach if they are not dropping off / picking up their child and must confirm to the coach the name of the "responsible individual" in advance of the training session or match.

In the event Parents are unable to drop off, remain on site and collect their child and are unable to appoint a 'responsible individual' for the duration of the training session, the child / children are not allowed to attend the training session / match.
